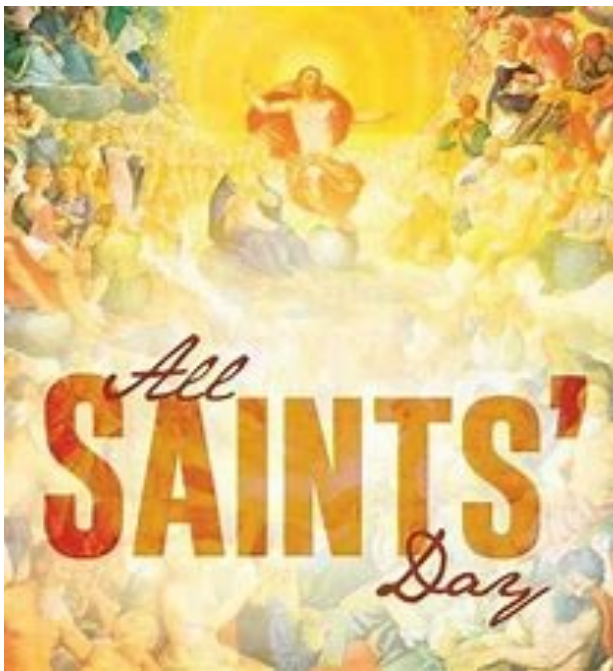

All the Readings of today's solemnity of All Saints Day refer, in different ways, to the Kingdom of Heaven. And all those who belong to Kingdom are saints. I see You all belong.

The Second Reading from the First Letter of John reminds us of the great love of God who has chosen to call us His children. During our sanctification through the power of the Holy Spirit, we are being transformed into the likeness of Christ. Here John reminds us of the great love of God who has chosen to call us His children and now enables us to be his saints. It only remains for God to finish the transformation by revealing himself totally to us in eternal glory. John tells us that when he is revealed, we will be like him, for we will see him as he is.

The First Reading from the book of Revelation presents an apocalyptic vision of those who have died in Christ. They represent every nation, tribe and language and now we know the Kingdom of God is for all.

Jesus did not say that Blessed are those who belong to this race or speak this language or have this citizenship. If so, that kingdom will be kingdom of chaos as we see now in the world. Jesus did say, "Blessed are the Poor; Morn; Meek; Clean of Heart;... I see and believe that these Blessed people are there in all races, languages and nations. As Catholics, it is our duty to come together as the blessed people accepting all race, language and citizenship without dismissing any rights or honor.

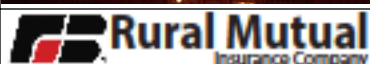
