

Each servant had his own work to do, and the gate-keeper's task was to be on watch for the man's return. In the same way we are to watch for the Lord's return, taking care to not fall asleep.

Reflection for us

There is an old saying, "When the cat's away, the mice begin to play!" When our boss isn't looking, it may be tempting for us to slow down the pace. When we aren't home, our children might be tempted to play rather than do their homework. But we are each in our own way called to be like the servants in today's Gospel story—staying faithful to whatever tasks we've been given whether the master (the boss, the parent) is away or at home. Today, pray to be faithful to the tasks you have been given as a parent, a spouse, a coworker, a friend, and a disciple of Jesus.
