We are at the close of Lent. Next week, Palm Sunday and we start the Tritium celebration. Tritium celebration has lots of religious practices which are traditionally observed. 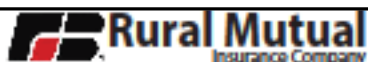
