We are at the close of Lent. Next week, Palm Sunday and we start the Tritium celebration. Tritium celebration has lots of religious practices which are traditionally observed. These practices take our life to a state of spirituality that allows our life to enjoy peace and joy of life. Tritium practices are not mere actions. They are actions filled with the grace of God. Know that Jesus took only his actions as witness to his earthly life. Only our actions could bring peace and joy to our life.
