## HOPE FOR A GENERATION IN CRISIS

This is a generation in crisis — of identity, of purpose and of belief. Faced with so many distractions, acts of violence, empty pleasures and a loss of faith in God, they are losing hope. For the sake of so many souls, the joyful message of Jesus Christ's life and salvation needs to be shared, now more than ever.

Recognizing the significant impact the college years have on a young person's future, Curtis Martin founded the Fellowship of Catholic University Students (FOCUS), starting with just two missionaries at Benedictine College in 1998.

Later that same year, he had the opportunity to meet Pope St. John Paul II and to share his vision for FOCUS: a chance for every student to know and feel known, loved and cared for by Jesus Christ. His Holiness listened carefully, and in response he simply told Curtis, "Be soldiers."

Driven by Pope St. John Paul II's call to the New Evangelization and encouraged to change the culture for Christ, FOCUS missionaries have spread the gospel message to tens of thousands of college students through on-campus outreach, Bible studies, discipleship, mission trips, national conferences and more.

Why? Because a heart that has encountered Jesus is a heart changed forever. Someone who knows Christ knows that life can never be the same without Him. It is He Who gives meaning to our lives, purpose to our gifts and direction to our desires. And those who have met Him desire nothing more than to share Him with the rest of the world.

EACH OF US is called to enter into Christ's mission, no matter where we are. Jesus tells us that! (Matt. 28:19-20, Luke 10:1-20). FOCUS missionaries answer that call by going to college and university campuses across the country, giving freely and joyfully of themselves to invite students into the journey to Christ's Kingdom.

Now one of our own, Katie Schuth, daughter of Judy and Bill Schuth, is entering this adventure of a lifetime — becoming a FOCUS missionary!

We too can enter this mission field by becoming Katie's partner in ministry, supporting her with our friendship, prayers and financial support ([focus.org/missionaries/catherine-schuth](http://focus.org/missionaries/catherine-schuth)). Pray about this! Then do as the Holy Spirit inspires you! Remember, Jesus says "Go!" not "Sit." It is not enough to be good, we need to be good for something! (James 2:17-26). "If you are who you were meant to be, you would set the world on fire!" (St. Catherine of Siena, Dialogue).
