When we relate closely with God in the solitude and silence of interior life then we can hear and discern what He calls us to do.

What is God's criteria for calling people to serve and how does one qualify? God does not look at the external features of a person or is He concerned about the qualification or skill. Without favoritism or prejudice, God extends His call equally to everyone. His criteria seem to be His trust that you can do it because He provides whatever is needed to accomplish the mission. But do we respond positively to God's call?

Trust in the Lord gives the way for true discipleship.




