

ASK FOR MORE

No matter what Jesus is doing in your life, He wants to give you more of His Holy Spirit. The key is learning there is more, asking for it, and receiving it.

Jesus gave all of us a mission: to love one another and to 'Go, make disciples of all nations' (see our mission statement!). We can't do this on our own power — we need more of the Holy Spirit; we need to pray, "God, I need more of Your Spirit. I need more of You because I see how little I have."

At this past weekend's conference on healing, we saw miracles that are only possible by the power of the Holy Spirit working through those who are yielded to Him.

As St. Bonaventure noted, this power *does not* come because of our efforts, study or holiness, *but* only through **our surrender to the Holy Spirit.**

Jesus said, 'He who believes in me, out of his heart will come rivers of living water' (Jn 7:38). Some of us only have a little trickle.

Do we have enough humility, enough trust, to ask our Heavenly Father for more of His Holy Spirit? Are we willing to risk what others may think of us in order to please Him?

St. Augustine saw so many miracles that he stated, "there is no lack of miracles in our day. And the God who works the miracles we read of in the Scripture uses any means and manner He chooses."

For him, miracles were not sent primarily by God to relieve pain (although that was a benefit), or to create a spectacle that would attract crowds, or to provide stories that would make a national best-seller. "Miracles have no purpose but to help men believe that Jesus Christ is God;" they demonstrate that He's alive; they validate His resurrection and help men's faith.

Do we love Jesus enough to personally give our lives to make Him known and loved? Who's our king—comfort or Christ? He told us following Him wouldn't be easy. Faith most certainly can be spelled **R.I. S.K.**—it's hard on the ego. So, ask for *more* of the Holy Spirit now! He, the power of God, is our helper!
