The FUNDAMENTAL for FAITH: WANTING -

The apostles said to the Lord, "Increase our faith" (Luke 17:5-6).

There's an old saying that what you want, you get. Many doubt this, thinking that they've wanted many things that they didn't get. The reason for this, however, is usually because they didn't want it enough. When we really want something (provided it is not an impossibility) we usually get it, because we have a passion for it. Many people who say that they don't have time to pray or to go to Mass still find time for recreation and TV. Why? Because they want to do these things. They don't find time to pray, to read the Bible or to go to Mass because God isn't their top priority. (just reference the Great Commandment, St. Mary's Mission Statement). He may be in their top 10, maybe even their top 5, but he's not #1. St. Thomas Aquinas tells us, "The things we love tell us what we are."

When the apostles ask the Lord to increase their faith, they're asking for a deeper desire to know Him. Too often we miss a step. We might ask the Lord to help us to pray when we really should be asking Him to give us the desire to pray. Desire to be close to Him and the things of His Kingdom, always, is the foundation of loving God and living with Him—always. When we want to pray, we will pray. When we want to be holy, we'll naturally strive to practice holiness, for virtue in all we think, say and do. It's all about what we truly desire. Ask the Lord to help you want Him and His kingdom. Ask the Lord for a new heart that has proper wants and desires. Ask the Lord for a new mind that has the proper priorities and prefers to think about what is good, true, and beautiful. What you want, you get.


