#### **Ignoring the Poor Is a Damnable Sin**

**Today Jesus gives us** an important lesson on judgment & Hell. Many can't understand how God, who is Love, can send anyone there, yet Jesus Himself taught this.

Hell has to exist for one reason: respect. God made us free & respects our freedom to choose His Kingdom—or not. His Kingdom has very specific values, fulfilled & experienced perfectly in Heaven.

The values of God's Kingdom include love, kindness, forgiveness, justice to the poor, generosity, humility, mercy, chastity, love of Scripture, love of truth, worship of God, & the centrality of God.

He will not force anyone to adopt & live them. Heaven is not what we want it to be; it is what God created it to be—the fulness of His Kingdom & His values.

The rich man's sin isn't one of hate but of indifference. His lifestyle rejects of one of the most significant Kingdom values: love of the poor. It damned him.

We're not exempt from caring for the poor if it is within our means to help them. God will <u>never</u> forget how we treat the poor (Amos 8:4-8). Here, the rich man either can't or won't change. He still sees Lazarus as beneath him, an errand boy to bring him water.

This helps explain why Hell is eternal. There comes a point in our life when our character is forever fixed, when we can no longer change.

**The Church Fathers** often thought of the human person as clay on a potter's wheel. When it's on the wheel & moist it can be molded & changed. When it is removed & placed in the fiery kiln, judgment day (*cf* 1 Cor 3:15), its shape can't be changed.

We are the rich man's brethren; "If we will not listen to Moses & the prophets, neither will we be persuaded if someone should rise from the dead." Scripture clearly lays out the way we're to walk. Do it! (Luke 18:22).

You & I are free to choose the Kingdom of God—or not. Jesus makes it clear that our daily choices lead ultimately to our final choice, a decision forever fixed.

The care of the poor is very important to God. Look through your closet this week & give away what you can. Are your finances pleasing to God? Give away what you can. The rich man was not cruel, just insensitive & unaware. Are we?


