

FAN OR FOLLOWER?

Today Jesus gives us four requirements necessary to be His disciple. Let's take a look at them.

The CONTEXT of discipleship – Jesus knew that many in the crowd following Him were just there "for the show"— like miracles, or free bread. What He gives them instead are hard teachings, distinguishing true disciples from those who merely give "lip service."

Jesus still prunes His Church this way. Today we see a great falling away, a pruning, as many who aren't able to accept the hard sayings of Jesus & the Scriptures about sexuality, forgiveness, love of one's enemies, heroic charity, & generosity, leave.

Many today argue that the Church should "get with the times." That's not the role of the Church. Her charter is to reflect the views of its Founder. As then, so now-Jesus' ways are not those of the current culture.

The CENTRALITY of discipleship – Jesus says we're saved if we remain in Him as His disciple, loving Him more than anyone (including family) or anything (including life itself). He's to be #1 in everything.

Your boss telling you to do something unethical? Just say, "Sorry, no can do." Your boyfriend or girlfriend pressuring you to have sex? Say, "Sorry, Dear." Your "friend" pressuring you to do drugs, get drunk, skip school, or steal? Say, "Sorry, Buddy." Your spouse calling you away from teaching your children the ways of the faith? Tell him/her "Sorry, Honey." Your child pressuring you to give him/her something unwise or sinful? Say, "Sorry, child of mine."

The CROSS of discipleship - Being a disciple doesn't mean we're exempted from the troubles of this world. We will be hated, persecuted, & severely tempted. But if we hold out to the end, heaven will be ours. Simply put: No cross, no crown.

Jesus points to the cross as the only way to glory. Even in this world, what we value most—family, talents, career, achievements – come at the cost of sacrifice.

The COST of discipleship – If the time we give to what we own, or our hobbies, or our recreation takes us away from loving & serving Jesus, we are not His.

So, what will it be? A wise man gives away what he cannot keep (his stuff) in order to gain what he could never buy (heaven). If we're not all in, we're out. Which will it he?
