

PHARISEES, PUBLICANS & CATHOLIC PRIDE

Occasionally I hear people say, "I'm proud to be a Catholic." I agree. I'm proud to be Catholic too. I'm amazed that the Lord has put me in this church that has been founded by Jesus Christ & contains the fullness & means of salvation as no other church does. But Catholic pride can sometimes cloak things that aren't so good – like arrogance, disdain for others, & dismissing the signs of grace that exist in other faith traditions.

Have we done this? If so, we need to confess it & repent. Arrogance does not honor God. His Word talks about how He resists the proud but gives grace to the humble. Let's not remain in a form of Catholic pride that scripture condemns.

The Church teaches, "Even though incorporated into the church, one who does not ... persevere in charity is not saved, who remains indeed in the bosom of the church, but in body, not in heart. All children of the church should... remember that their exalted condition results not from their own merits, but from the grace of **Christ.** If they fail to respond in thought, word indeed to that grace, not only shall they not be saved, but they shall be the more severely judged."

In plain English, it's possible to be Catholic, going to mass, engaged in her committees, serving in her ministries, a member of the choir – & still not be saved. We're not saved if we're not responding to His gift in faith, being Catholic in thought, word, & deed.

Jesus says, "Not everyone who says to me, Lord, Lord will enter the kingdom of God, but only the one who does the will of my Father in heaven." It seems pretty radical to say that one can be a "faithful" churchgoing Catholic & not be saved, but it's what Jesus & His Church teach. He's God – He should know. Right?

It's true that Catholic pride can have a healthy expression. But more importantly, we should focus on humility & gratitude for the gift of being Catholic. Really, we can't take pride in it. We didn't earn it. We don't deserve it. It's pure gift – God's grace.

So – Catholic gratitude, yes; Catholic humility, yes; Catholic love, yes; Catholic kindness, yes; Catholic Holiness, yes! Let our primary attitude towards being a Catholic be gratitude & not arrogance. Let's keep growing in humility & the ability to recognize all that is good in others, in other faith traditions. Amen.




