

5 LESSONS IN GRATITUDE FROM JESUS & THE 10 LEPERS

Unlike other accounts of Jesus' miracles, today's focus on Jesus & the 10 lepers is not on the healing itself but on what happens before & after.

What Can We Learn from this account?

God Values the Least: He places honor on the lowest of the low, lepers, even the Samaritan, by hearing their cries, & healing them.

God Honors Faith: They weren't healed until they acted on the faith they had & did what Jesus told them to do. God will never let us off the hook of faith (Heb. 11:6).

God Cherishes Gratitude: Even more than the measure of our faith, God cherishes gratitude. Only one of the 10 lepers turned back, fell at Jesus' feet, & thanked Him—loudly. He didn't need to continue on to the priest—his faith had saved him. Why? Because he'd returned to Grace & Mercy Himself.

Gratitude is at the core of our being His disciple. It's God's will that we learn to be grateful in every situation (1 Th. 5:18). It tells Him that we trust Him.

The question then is how do we give thanks & keep an attitude of gratitude in our busy lives?

5 Practical Ways to Thank God Daily

- **1. Keep a blessing journal** at the dinner table. Strengthen your gratitude muscle by writing down your top 3 blessings, big or small, every day.
- **2. Develop a daily rhythm** of thanking God. Before rising thank Him for His great love. Before sleep thank Him for His faithfulness that you experienced that day.
- **3. Set an alarm** on your phone to remind you at specific times to thank God for His gifts (Ps. 119:164). Wouldn't God find that time with you most pleasing?
- **4. Forgive** those who've hurt you. As you forgive, remember His love for you & how He forgave you. Your gratitude will grow & it'll become much easier to forgive others.
- **5. Listen** to worship music & hymns to prompt your thanksgiving. St. Augustine said, "He who sings prays twice."

Above all, ask the Holy Spirit to help you develop a heart of gratitude. This pleases God so very much.
