# MASS ON THE MOVE

In today's Gospel we encounter two discouraged & downcast men making their way to Emmaus. They're looking down, not up. The One they thought would liberate Israel has been cruelly killed. It is late afternoon & they're leaving town.

They cannot see or understand God's plan, that Jesus must be alive, just as the women reported. They're blind to the miracle that happened just hours before.

Aren't they like us? We often struggle to understand Life's sufferings when, in Jesus Christ, we've already won the victory over its vicissitudes. In Him, this life is NOT the end! Too easily our eyes are cast downward in depression rather than upward in faith.

How will the Lord give them (& us) this vision? How will He enable them to see His risen glory? How will He encourage them to look up, away from their downward focus, & behold new life?

He'll do it in the context of the Mass, He'll open their eyes & they'll recognize Him. There they'll see His glory & the new life.

Jesus enters their little group (Gathering Rite), asks what's troubling them (Penitential Rite), breaks open & interprets the scriptures (Liturgy of the Word). Having head the Word, they make a request of Jesus (Intercessory Prayer). Then the bread is blessed, broken & given (Liturgy of the Eucharist). They are the same actions that took place at the Last Supper; it opens their eyes & they recognize Him.

The liturgy & the sacraments are not mere rituals; they are encounters with the risen Christ. When our faith drops the 18" from our head to our heart, our eyes are opened & we learn to see & hear Jesus Christ in the liturgy, & to experience His ministry to us.

The two disciples <u>ran</u> seven miles back to tell their brethren how they encountered Jesus.

How about us? At the end of Mass, the priest or deacon says, "The Mass is ended. Go in peace." *Ite Missa Est Go, you have been dismissed.* This does <u>not</u> mean, "We're done, go home & have nice day." It means, "<u>Go</u> into the world & bring the Christ you've received to others." It's a perfect time to do some evangelization & works of mercy. Bring God's love to your world!
