I WILL NOT LEAVE YOU ORPHANS

The overarching purpose of Jesus mission was to renew our relationship with the Father, to take us from being orphans, separated from Him by sin, & to restore us to Him as His sons & daughters.

So many people today exhibit signs of being orphans, separated from God, the source of life: by a sense of interior loneliness felt even when surrounded by people; by an existential sadness springing from the attempt to be free of God; by the all-too-common spiritual illiteracy which renders them incapable of prayer; by the difficulty in grasping the truth & reality of eternal life as that fullness of communion which begins on earth & reaches full flower after death; & by the effort to see others as "brothers" & "sisters", since we're all children of the same Father.

Being a child of God runs contrary to all this. We were made to be God's children; it's in our DNA. But our relationship to Him, as of a father to his children, was ruined by our sin. Really, we can hardly even begin to imagine the magnitude of our sin, a wrong so great it required the 'awe-ful' sacrifice of God's only begotten Son. Yet He took upon Himself the punishment due us all, fulfilling God's just sentence, for as God Himself declared, "the soul that sins shall die."

Then, after Jesus resurrected, He ascended to the Father, & to those who repent & believe in Him, He gives that same awesome, immense gift of His love, the Holy Spirit, so that we too might become as He is, a son or daughter of God, sharing that same Holy Spirit.

St. Paul writes, "Anyone who does not have the Spirit of Christ does not belong to Him." Strengthening our relationship of belonging to the Lord Jesus, the Holy Spirit enables us, through our universal Brother Jesus, to relate to Him & to one another in a new way; no longer as orphans, but rather as uniquely different children of the same good & merciful Father!

He also writes, "For all who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God. For you did not receive the spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you have received the spirit of sonship, which enables us to cry out, 'Abba, Father." By His Spirit we are no longer orphans, separated from Him! We are sons & daughters of God, the Father! He lives in us by His Spirit—we have become His temple!




