

# WHO, ME?

The disciples went to the mountain to which Jesus had ordered them. That's us, going to Mass.

They worshipped, but some doubted. That too is us.

Then Jesus approached & said to them (us—we who call ourselves disciples), "Go & make disciples of all, baptizing them in the name of the Father, & of the Son, & of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you."

This is a part of St. Mary's mission statement (see OUR MISSION on the next page). How are we doing with that?

A disciple takes on the yoke, the worldview & teachings, of their master. How are we doing with that? Is our worldview that of a modernistic philosophy, or of a political party, or of the current culture? Or is our worldview that of Jesus Christ, the Son of God?

Pope Francis says, "Every Christian is called to be a missionary, sharing the good news of salvation in Christ & making disciples for Him, not for oneself or one's clique of like-minded believers."

"What instructions does the Lord give us for going forth to others? Only one, & it's very simple: Make disciples. But be careful: His disciples, not our own,"

Our mission begins when Mass ends. Mass isn't the mission; what we do after is. Mass is for worship; mission is for the transformation of the world one person at a time.

Let's not be like the servant who buried the one talent his master had given him. In humble obedience to Him, let's take that talent, even if it seems little, & reschedule our lives to use it to build bridges of trust & friendship with those who seem so far away from Him. He promised that He'd always be with us in this. Let's begin—today—trusting Him to do as He promised.

"Christ has no body now but yours. No hands, no feet on earth but yours. Yours are the eyes through which He looks compassion on this world. Yours are the feet with which He walks to do good. Yours are the hands through which He blesses all the world. Yours are the hands, yours are the feet, yours are the eyes, you are His body. Christ has no body now on earth but yours." 
