#### Pentecost Sunday: The Birthday of the Church

The solemnity of Pentecost which commemorates the descent of the holy spirit upon the Apostles and marks the public manifestation of Christ's church to the entire humanity.

The word PENTECOST comes from the Greek word *PENTECOSTES*, meaning 50th to indicate the moment of the Holy Spirit's descent at the 50th day after the Resurrection of Christ.

God the Holy Spirit is the 3rd person of the most Holy Trinity. He is the Love which proceeds from the Father and the Son, the Consoler, Sanctifier, Soul of the Church, and our Teacher in our life as Christians.

Pentecost is the feast of the Holy Spirit. Pentecost is the day when we remember the birth of the Church as we know it. For once the Holy Spirit was poured out on the Church, she began to carry out her mission. The Holy Spirit gives the Church the power to act in the person of Christ for the salvation of the world.

In one way this is the end of something, the end of the Easter season. But it's the beginning of something too: the beginning of Ordinary Time. Ordinary time is the time of the Church. This is the time of the Holy Spirit, at work in the world. The Church of Christ carries out his work.

Pentecost celebrates the creation of the Christianity. Pentecost is the birthday of the Church, because, on Pentecost we celebrate the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the apostles gathered in the upper room in Jerusalem; this event marks the beginning of the Church. So, it is the Spirit that brings us together today.

Jesus calls us for a mission. Let us remember that this mission was not given to the apostles alone, but to the whole Church. All of us are responsible to preach the gospel, to lead others closer to Christ, to make this world a holier place where God can dwell.

Today is a day for us to open our hearts to the Spirit of Truth. He will teach us and strengthen our faith in the truth. Let the Holy Spirit help us to walk in the way of Christ.
