World Mission Sunday (Oct 22): "Hearts on Fire, Feet on the Move"

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ, October is the month that traditionally been a powerful period of reflection and mobilization for our Church's missionary efforts. It is on behalf of the missionary men and women spreading the gospel in 1,150 mission territories, to seek our support humbly and boldly.

It is a profound opportunity to renew our commitment to the great commission. World Mission Sunday is celebrated globally on the penultimate weekend of October falls on the 22nd this year. It serves as a clarion call to mobilize faith, resources, and action in advancing the gospel to our brothers and sisters living in the furthest reaches of our world.

As the theme for this year's world Mission Sunday, Pope Francis has chosen: "Hearts on Fire, Feet on the Move". Pope Pius XI instituted World Mission Sunday in 1926, to help over 1,100 dioceses that cannot sustain themselves because they are too poor, young, or actively persecuted. We all are responsible for praying for the Church, where Christ's redeeming message has yet to be heard, forgotten, rejected, or shunned.

My dear people, with our daily prayer and our generous donation on World Mission Sunday, we all bear witness to the compassion of our Lord Jesus Christ, making Him present in every continent, country, city, family, and heart.
