#### Advent: A call for Life of Holiness

My Dear Brothers and Sisters, the second Sunday of Advent invites us to take hold of the Lord's coming as an opportunity to stir up our desire for God, to deepen our awareness of His love for us.

The first reading from the prophet Isaiah makes us to understand that it is God Himself who wants to give us comfort, but He can only do so insofar as our hearts are open and waiting for Him. It is God who invites us to be patient.

In the second reading St. Peter reminds us that as we await the Lord, whether he comes early or not, we must not relapse into sin or take advantage of his delay to do evil. St. Peter further shows us that, preparation for the way of the Lord is a call for holiness. For this, we are expected to be found at peace with God, ourselves, and everyone.

The Gospel of Mark points at John the Baptist as the precursor who had been sent to prepare the way of the Messiah. John went about calling the people to remove all obstacle impeding the coming of the Messiah through total repentance from sin to God.

John's ministry is marked with baptism of repentance which is different from ritual baptism. Baptism becomes ritual when repentance is not achieved as result. Repentance is turning away from sin, evil traditions, customs, and bad habits to God through righteous living. Genuine repentance is a work of God on human heart.

Therefore, we are invited to prepare for Christmas by repenting of our sins and renewing our lives so that Jesus may be reborn in us. People around us should recognize Jesus' rebirth in our lives by our sharing love, unconditional forgiveness, compassionate and merciful heart, and spirit of humble and committed service.

May our daily repentance make us worthy to receive Jesus Christ.

May our preparation for this period bring comfort and consoling moment to us.
