

Eucharist the Wonderful Gift of God

My Dear Brothers and Sisters, the twentieth Sunday readings especially, the gospel continues to tell us that Jesus is the bread of life. This is simply to remind us of the importance of the Holy Eucharist in our Christian life. Eucharist means thanksgiving. So, today we give thanks to God for this precious gift.

In today's first reading, God who himself is Wisdom, invites us to his banquet. However, only the humble can appreciate and take advantage of this invitation. The Eucharist is a special banquet where Christ is both the giver and the gift.

In today's gospel when Christ said: "I am the living bread that came down from heaven, anyone who eats this bread will live forever", the Jews became enraged. The reason is simple. They were full of pride and lacked true wisdom. They could not comprehend what Christ meant. They refused to be humbled, in order to become wise in the ways of God.

At times, some people try to analyze and comprehend this great mystery of Faith only with our limited human wisdom. So, like the Jews, some still wonder: "How could He give us His body and blood to eat and drink?" Is Christ really present in the Eucharist?

Hence, Paul warns us today to Be careful about the sort of lives we live, like intelligent and not senseless people. Only intelligent and thoughtful people see and encounter Christ in the Holy Eucharist.

They are the ones who do not doubt that Christ is the living bread of life and is present in the Holy Eucharist. They respond to God's invitation to have life and real wisdom. They know that the fullness of life is in Christ, the living bread of life.

Therefore, let us respond positively to God's invitation to share the Eucharistic banquet and true wisdom. So, let us humble ourselves and as Palmist says, "Taste and see that the Lord is good!" God Bless You All!
