Christ the Bread of Life

On this eighteenth Sunday, we rejoice because of the incredible nourishment that God gives us daily through Christ, the bread of life. As Christians, by receiving and putting on Christ, we undergo a spiritual revolution. So, Christ provides us the spiritual food for our journey through the Eucharist.

The first reading reminds us that the Israelites murmured and revolted against Moses, and consequently, against God. They doubted and put God to the test. They hastily forgot how good and merciful He has been to them. However, God proved that He is a great provider. He feeds them to satisfaction.

In the gospel, Jesus read the mind of the people following him, like the Israelites, his followers become obsessed with food. They were carried away by physical hunger. They came to search for their daily bread but failed to recognize that Christ was the bread of life

Therefore, when we pay too much attention to material things, we forfeit the spiritual meaning of life. Unfortunately, at times we act like the Israelites by murmuring against God. For some of us, "God is good" only when things are okay. However, when we are faced with difficulties, we forget all his goodness.

Hence in the second reading Paul advised us to give up our old ways of life which are corrupted by illusory desires. Illusory desires prevent us from appreciating God's goodness. They leave us with spiritual starvation.

Spiritual starvation is the root of all weaknesses. So, to put on the new man means to protect and nourish our soul spiritually, especially when our physical body is weak and suffers.

My dear brothers and sisters, Christ is the bread of our life. He is present in the Holy Eucharist. Each time we celebrate Him, we celebrate and receive life. We are indeed blessed as we pray at every Mass: "Blessed are those called to the Lord's supper."
