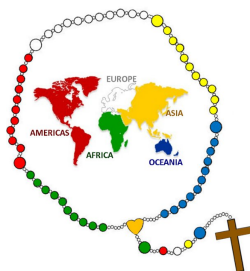

This was created by Archbishop Fulton Sheen in 1951. It is a unique way to pray for the missions around the world. Each decade of the Rosary is for a different region of the world.

- **Green Beads** represent Africa, symbolizing the forests and grasslands.
- **Blue Beads** represent the Pacific Ocean, symbolizing the islands of the Pacific.
- **White Beads** represent Europe, symbolizing the seat of the Holy Father.
- **Red Beads** represent the Americas, symbolizing the fire of faith brought by missionaries.
- **Yellow Beads** represent Asia, symbolizing the morning light of the East
