The Joy of Christmas

My dear Brothers and Sisters, the 4th Sunday of Advent invites us to be ready for the coming of Jesus. The readings help us prepare our hearts for the joy of Christmas.

In the First Reading, God promises to send a ruler from Bethlehem. He will shepherd Israel, bring peace, and his greatness will reach the ends of the earth.

The Second Reading tells us that Jesus came to do God's will. Christ replaced old sacrifices with his own body, fulfilling God's will. His sacrifice made us holy once and for all.

The gospel presents us the visitation of Mary to her cousin Elizabeth. Despite her pregnancy, Mary still found time to visit her cousin to share her joy and to assist her. Elizabeth, filled with the Holy Spirit, blessed Mary for her faith and for bearing the Lord. Blessed are you among women, and blessed is the fruit of your womb.

Like the visit of Mary to Elizabeth, God has planned to visit us personally to bring us transformation and it will provoke peace and greater joy in our hearts as it did for Elizabeth and the child in her womb.

The Joy of Christmas: Jesus was born in Bethlehem, which means "house of bread." Because there was no room in the inn Jesus was born in a stable and laid in a manger, which is significant because it is a feeding trough for animals.

This was all part of God's plan for His birth on Earth, to point to the fact that Jesus came to save us. This is really the whole meaning of Christmas. Jesus came to give us Himself as food – He literally is the Bread of Life that saves us, that spiritually nourishes and strengthens us with His grace.

God has made this feast day a feast of love. With great compassion, God so loves the world that He sends His Only Son. This is His Christmas gift.

May the Child Jesus come to you with the gift of Love, the blessing of Hope and the promise of Peace. I wish all of you Merry Christmas.


