Our PCCW is going to be working on two projects for Lenten Almsgiving. All funds donated from our soup suppers and any other donations that are collected will be used for these two projects. ### • Project Milk

Project Milk was started in 1984 by the Rural Life Committee of the Diocese of La Crosse in connection with Father Joseph Walijewski, founder of the Casa Hogar orphanage in Peru. Project Milk sends sacks of powdered milk from the dairy farms of Wisconsin to the children of the Casa Hogar orphanage and their communities across Lima, Peru.

It costs \$100 to send one 50-pound bag of dried milk to Peru. That is enough milk for the 72 children of Casa Hogar for one week. For more information on this project: check the Diocese of La Crosse webpage.
