The Risen Lord is Merciful (Divine Mercy)

My Dear brothers and Sisters, Today is the second Sunday of Easter. The Church and her faithful continue to worship the risen Christ, who is now alive forever. Today is also Divine Mercy Sunday. So, we celebrate the mercy that God shows to the world by sending his Son to die for our salvation.

In today's first reading, we see the power of the risen Christ at work in the life and actions of His disciples. Through this power, many believed, and Christ worked miracles. Jesus manifested his living and glorious presence through his apostles. In the second reading, He assures us: I am the Living One. I was dead, and now I am to live forever and ever".

In today's gospel, Jesus visited his timid disciples. This gospel teaches us that our faith is distinct from mere sensible knowledge. This visit to his disciples was very significant, first to convince them that he was real. Second, to restore their faith and peace. Hence, he said to them: "Peace be with you."

Third, it was to empower them spiritually. So, "He breathed on them saying: Receive the Holy Spirit." Christ's visit restored their courage and faith. However, it took time for Thomas to believe that Christ has risen.

Therefore, we must expel the spirit of doubt and fear from our lives to experience the power of the resurrected Christ.

As we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday today, Let's have a heart for the poor and suffering, or better still, to have a heart willing to suffer for others. Mercy is what the world and the Church need now more than ever. It is the only effective way to reconciliation, unity and peace.

My Dear Brothers and Sisters let's Congratulate and appreciate the eighth First Holy Communicants on this special day! May your journey of faith be filled with joy, peace, and the blessings of God. This is a significant milestone, a time to celebrate your faith and the love of Christ. God Bless You All!


