A Call to Trust and Readiness

My Dear Brothers and Sisters, on this 19th Sunday, the Church reminds us of our true identity and our readiness to serve and love as the people of God, firmly rooted in Christ.

The readings call us to a life of faith, trust, and watchful readiness. They remind us that God is faithful to His promises and that we are part of His saving plan, just like the men and women of faith in the Scriptures.

In the first reading we hear of the Israelites who waited in hope and confidence for God's deliverance. They were not just waiting passively—they were prepared, trusting that God would act on their behalf. Their readiness was rooted in the covenant they had with God.

In the second reading we are reminded of Abraham, the father of faith. Abraham obeyed God without knowing where he was going. His life shows us that true faith means following God even when we don't have all the answers. It means believing in God's promises even when we can't see their fulfillment yet.

In the Gospel, Jesus urges us to "be ready," like servants waiting for their master's return. This is not just a warning, but a loving reminder that we must live each day with purpose and awareness. We are called to stay spiritually awake, responsible, and faithful in whatever mission God has entrusted to us.

This Sunday reminds us that faith is not only belief, also it is a way of life. It shapes how we act, how we wait, how we serve, and how we love. God's promises are sure, but we must do our part by remaining alert and faithful.

Let us ask the Lord for hearts that trust, eyes that watch, and lives that reflect the joy of being His chosen people." Have a Blessed weekend! God Bless You All!
