Advent: A Call to Watch and Prepare

My Dear Brothers and Sisters, this weekend we joyfully enter the season of Advent, a sacred time of preparation and renewal. Advent means "coming," and the Church reminds us that Christ comes to us in three profound ways:

He came in history at Bethlehem, He comes to us now through grace and the sacraments, and He will come again in glory. This season invites us to open our hearts to all three comings with sincere expectation and hope.

In the first reading, the prophet Isaiah offers a striking image of peace: nations laying down their weapons and walking together in harmony. This vision reminds us that God desires a world where people choose understanding instead of conflict.

Advent becomes a perfect moment for each of us to bring peace to our homes, our families, or perhaps within our own hearts. Being a peacemaker does not mean avoiding problems, but approaching them with patience, kindness, and compassion. Every step toward peace prepares our hearts for Christ, the Prince of Peace.

Saint Paul urges us this weekend to "put on the armor of light" and leave behind anything that brings darkness into our lives. Advent gives us a spiritual reset—a chance to examine our attitudes and actions. Living in the light is not about being perfect; it is about choosing goodness each day.

This season also invites us to renew our faith in simple, daily ways: a moment of prayer, an act of charity, gratitude for God's blessings, or intentional awareness of His presence.

Finally, Advent calls us to stay spiritually awake. Like waiting for someone we deeply love, we watch for Christ with hopeful expectation. May this Advent season help us choose peace, walk in the light, renew our faith, and joyfully prepare our hearts for the Lord's coming.
