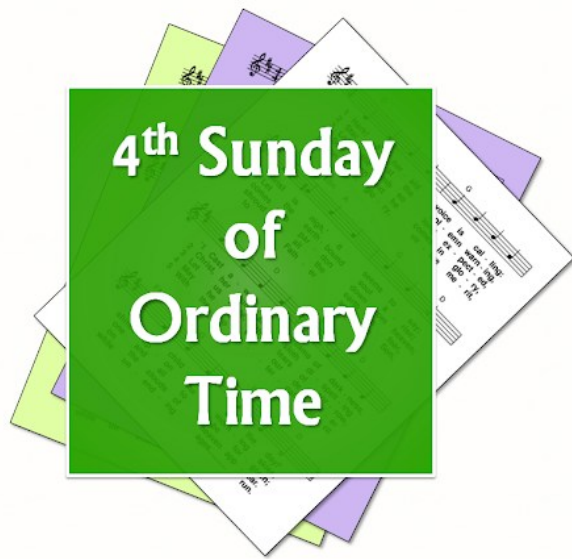

THE BLESSED PATH

The Beatitudes mark the fulfillment of God's covenant promise to Abraham—that through his descendants God would bless all the nations of the world.

Jesus, the son of Abraham, the son of David, and the Son of God, bestows the Father's blessings upon "the poor in spirit."

He chooses to bless the weak & lowly, the foolish & despised in the eyes of the world. The poor in spirit are those who know that nothing they do can merit His mercy & grace, the humble remnant of the 1st reading who seek refuge in the name of the Lord.

Are we poor in spirit? Have we recognized that no matter our social status, no matter our financial standing, no matter our intellectual acuity, we are saved by God's grace and not by who we are or anything we have done? As it is written, "God is no respecter of persons." (Acts 10:34, Rom. 2:11). Pride in who we are, in what we've done, or in what we have, is anathema to God Who has given us all we have & all we are out of His love for us—for His glory, not for ours!

The Beatitudes reveal the divine path & purpose for our lives. All our striving should be for these virtues—to be poor in spirit; meek & holy of heart; merciful & makers of peace; seekers of the righteousness that comes from living the law of Kingdom out of love for God.

The path the Lord sets before us today is one of trials & persecution. But He promises comfort in our mourning & a great reward in the end.

Even when life gets messy, relationships get difficult, our job becomes a grind, a loved one dies, we need to remember that we are not made for this world. St. Francis De Sales tells us to, "Say frequently in the midst of your contradictions, 'This is the path to heaven.'" It works! When we look at our present reality through an eternal perspective, seeing our life in light of heaven, everything changes.

The Kingdom we inherit is not of earth, but the promised land of heaven, where the Lord reigns forever. As we sing in today's Psalm, its blessings are for those whose hope is in the Lord.
