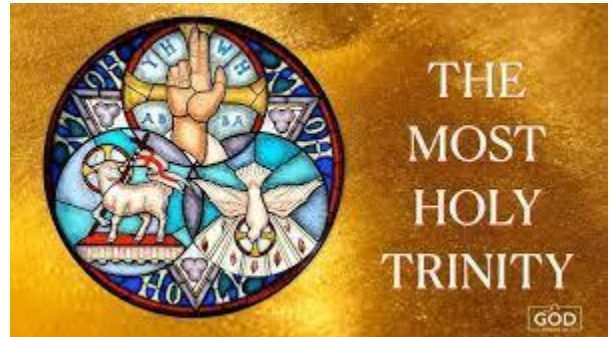

Stewardship Bulletin Reflection

Ex 34:4b-6, 8-9; DN 3:52-56; 2 COR 13:11-13; JN 3:16-18

The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity—the central mystery of our faith. Though the Trinity is a profound mystery, it also reveals something practical for us as Christian stewards. The Trinity, as a communion of Persons who give themselves completely to one another, shows us that self-giving love is at the heart of the stewardship way of life.

In our Gospel, we hear, “God so loved the world that he gave his only Son.” God’s self-giving love calls us to respond by giving ourselves in love and service to others, fostering a sense of meaningful purposes. The more we give ourselves in love, the more we experience “the grace of the Lord, the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit” within us. This triune God invites us into a deeper relationship with Him—one that deepens as we live actively in gratitude and self-gift through stewardship.
