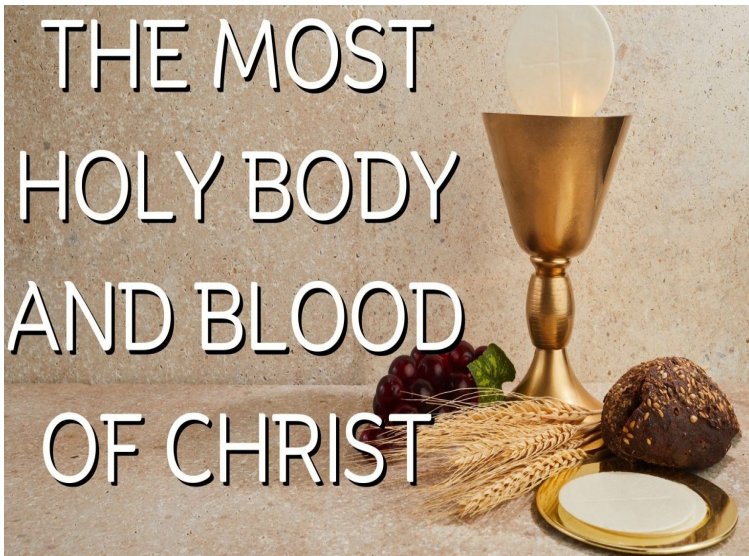

**Corpus Christi: The Gift That Nourishes the World**

My Dear Brothers and Sisters, today we celebrate Corpus Christi, the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ. This feast reminds us of the Church's greatest gift, the Holy Eucharist, where Jesus continues to nourish, strengthen, and remain with His people.

Throughout salvation history, God has always fed His people. He provided manna in the desert for the Israelites. Jesus multiplied loaves and fishes for the hungry crowds. Ultimately, He gave His very self as the Bread of Life. In the Eucharist, Christ fulfills His promise to remain with us always.

The Eucharist is a gift of love. Every time we participate in Mass, we are reminded that God does not keep His love at a distance. He comes close to us, entering our hearts and our lives. The Eucharist reminds us that we belong to one another and are called to build a community marked by compassion, peace, and mutual respect.

As we celebrate this beautiful feast, may our hearts be filled with gratitude for the gift of the Eucharist. May we approach the Lord's table with reverence and joy, allowing His presence to transform us and draw us ever closer to Him and to one another.
