REFLECTION ON THE 2ND READING

Today's second reading contains two of the three verses in the New Testament where an Apostle explicitly states what God's will is for us: "God our savior...wills everyone to be saved & come to knowledge of the truth."

Now many these days think, "I don't need to do anything because God desires everyone to be saved," WRONG! That's a heresy called 'universalism.'

Jesus says, "Strive to enter by the narrow door; for many, I tell you, will seek to enter & will not be able", and "I AM the way, & the truth, & the life; no one comes to the Father, but by Me. "

The root sin of the world is refusal to believe in Jesus & the place He holds as the Revelation of the Father. The root sin of the world is to reject this Truth.

So how would we describe SALVATION? We'll look at what it's not, then at what it is.

It's not self-help. I can't save myself, no matter how hard I try (Pelagianism). It's a gift.

It's not just "fire insurance", it's abundant life —to be *like* Jesus & with Jesus.

It's not without cost. The goal of salvation is entering into God's life of love. On the cross, Jesus shows me what it costs to be saved, to love like God.

It's not just personal, it's also a relationship with all who are in Christ Jesus through Baptism.

It's not a spectator sport. It's living like we believe it—not as those of whom Jesus said, "This people honors Me with their lips, but their heart is far from Me."

It's not simply a moment, it's a process. I'm to be transformed, working out my salvation with Him. He's at work in me to will & to work His good pleasure!

It's not inevitable, as in "once saved, always saved." God <u>always</u> honors my free will. I always have a choice—will I do what I want or what God desires?

It's not just for other people. They're not the only ones who need to change. I do. I need to be born again & to think & act, not the culture does, but as Jesus does.

It's not only about the future, it's about the now. At the moment of temptation, am I ready to nail my disordered desires to the cross, killing it there by doing what God wants, not what I want?

This then is salvation. If I'm in Him, I am saved, I am being saved, & I will be saved.


