GN 14:18-20; PS 110: 1,2,3,4; 1 COR 11:23-26; LK 9:11b-17

**The Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ.** Today we celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ. Our readings highlight the incredible gift of the Eucharist. As stewards, we recognize that all we are and all we have are gifts from God. Among the greatest of these gifts is the Eucharist—Christ’s Body and Blood, given to us for our spiritual nourishment. Jesus makes this clear in the Gospel through the miracle of the multiplication of the loaves. He takes what is offered, blesses it, and transforms it into more than enough to feed the crowd. The same is true in our lives. When we offer our gifts to the Lord, He lovingly multiplies them beyond what we could ever imagine, filling us with hope and trust in His grace. Through the Eucharist, we are strengthened to live as stewards. Let us receive this gift with gratitude and allow it to transform how we live, give, and serve.
